

CAMP DATES for 2009, June 27th to August 9th. Escorts are provided on specified airline flights. There is a charter bus to and from Chicago on these dates.

TUITION is \$5395.00, less 5% when there are multiple enrollments from one family. It covers all necessary expenses, including riding, and canoe trips. Tuition does not include transportation between home and camp or personal expenses. There is no allowance for late arrival or early departure.

TUTORING by qualified teachers in Reading, English, Math, Typewriting, or Computer may be elected at an additional cost of \$200.

SPENDING MONEY, \$75.00, is recommended for personal supplies such as camp store items, cash withdrawals, special trips, activity awards, medical expenses, airport transport other than camp dates, rifle ammunition, craft supplies, etc. This is payable in advance, to serve as a drawing account for the camper. An itemization of expenditures will be reported at the end of the season.

This application and deposit constitutes an enrollment only when accepted in writing by Towering Pines or Woodland. The membership card will be mailed when the registration is accepted. Waiting list deposits are refunded in full if we are unable to confirm a reservation.

Conditions for Membership

The camps are open to boys and girls of good character regardless of race, color or creed. There is special emphasis on geographical diversity. We reserve the right to accept or reject applicants.

Submission of the application implies understanding and agreement by camper and parents of the policy that there be no use of tobacco, drugs of abuse or alcohol in camp or on trips during the season. A camper is subject to dismissal without tuition refund for behavior that, in our judgment, is contrary to the best interests of the group.

Visitors are welcome. However, only parents are permitted to take campers from the grounds. Experience has shown that health, happiness and personal accomplishment are far better for campers who give themselves fully to the program instead of leaving for any period of time.

Participation in every activity includes instruction in safety practices designed to protect the camper. Enrollments are accepted with the understanding that the camper may participate in all activities.
