CAMP DATES for 2019, June 22nd to August 4. Escorts are provided on specified airline flights. There is a charter bus to and from Chicago O'Hare airport on these dates for an additional fee. Short-term enrollments will be accepted with the opportunity to extend for the full six week camp term.
